- 1. Students are advised to visit the websites of respective colleges for further information.
- 2. Students must fulfil the eligibility criteria for admission to the 4th year as laid down by the affiliating university of the college they wish to seek admission.
- 3. Admissions are provisional and will be confirmed only when the minimum enrolment of a subject is reached, failing which the students will be required to shift to other colleges.
- 4. In case the Minor field of study of a student is not offered by the college to which they are migrating, the colleges can: (a) Collaborate with a neighbouring college for offering the minor, or (b) offer blended/hybrid delivery using prescribed MOOCs or University-approved online modules in consultation with the Board of Studies.
